Materials needed for this course/workshop:

2B Pencil, Rubber and Eraser, hard and soft charcoal stick

0.5mm Black felt tipped drawing Pen, water resistant . (No Marker please) Tutor will have these for sale at \$2.50 each

Small bottle of black waterproof, drawing ink, branded Windsor and Newton/FW or Art Spectrum

Sharp pointed old fashioned fountain pen if possible to obtain. Tutor will have new fountain pens for sale at a cost of \$10.00

Paper for studies and notes

COMO or Field pad of Watercolour paper (hot paper, smooth surface) appr 220grms .Other brands welcome, smooth paper (HOT) is preferred.

Flat, pointed brush (cat's tongue) size 8, Brand Neef, squirrel mix, 2 cm wide at silver base and 2-3 cm long. Barcode number: 9330173007386 This brush is sufficient for all your paint work. Do not buy a variety of small brushes as the described brush is used for all purposes.

Somewhat bigger than A3 laminated or ply sheet (40cm x 50cm) to tape watercolour paper onto to therefore minimizing the chance that the paper is wobbling.

Masking tape (1-2 inch wide) to tape the paper on your working board as described.

Watercolour palette with plenty of mixing space

Water container, Tissues/ Rags

Watercolour tubes or tablets branded Cotmans/Windsor & Newton/Art Spectrum/ Schmincke or similar (No Reeves/ Marie's or other primary school/ childcare paints as they will hinder your painting development)

Colours needed: Ultramarine, Cobalt blue, Indigo, Turquoise, Cad Red, Permanent Rose, Cad yellow, Sap green, Hookers green, Yellow ochre, Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber, Raw Sienna, and if possible: Emerald and Turqoise.

Optional for mixed media: Candle wax, pastel sticks, colour pencils, toothbrush, natural sponge.
