Course Description

All Levels of Experience are Welcome

Good drawing skills, Focus on Individual work, Mixing delightful Colours, Variety of Topics in Pen and Watercolour with some Mixed Media

Cees will help you to discover new ways of sketching in pen, adding a wash or producing a full watercolour and some mixed media if you like. Our aim is to let the artist within you come out and explore your field of creativity. Therefore everyone's work is different and Cees will help you to find your unique style. From day 1 we will commence our varied program which if possible includes: a Still Life with flowers, a Landscape, a bird, an Old Cottage, an Interior and even a portrait. The media we use would be very suitable and portable in particular when you intend to go out and about or on holidays, touring the country side. You could illustrate your own travel diary or make a coffee table book of sketches combined with photographs of places you have enjoyed. So if you are starting out or are already experienced, come along, enjoy and learn.

Day 1: (i) The interior of an old cottage

(ii) An old Cottage in the Australian country side

On this day we focus on character, tradition and nostalgia . Learning to to draw with the pen using the dip-in method.

Day 2: (i) Seascape with rocks

(ii) Ducks in the water

On this day we focus on drawing and painting water, reflection and rocks as well as how to draw and paint feathers using the felt tipped drawing pen.

Day 3:

- (i) Drawing and painting a bunch of flowers
- (ii) A tropical forest

On this day we focus on working with trees, painting greens and foliage Also doing flower arrangements

Day 4:

- (i) Drawing and painting a portrait
- (ii) Drawing and painting boats

On this day we will focus on facial proportions and skin colour Also drawing shapes of boats, moored.

Please note that the program lay out is not binding. Ability and interest of the students play an important part in doing more or less in this course. Changes may be made at the tutor's discretion in order to make the program more effective and student focussed.
